All tetrads have been allocated and all surveyors have been contacted and have given assurances of their completion.

It is possible some common species are under-recorded so there is great value in providing as many Roving Records as possible (I will be grateful for any RRs from 10km square NS53.)

Now is the season to ‘up’ the breeding levels *possible-> probable -> confirmed*, for many species in many squares.

CONGRATULATIONS we successfully completed the winter minimum requirements for all of Ayrshire’s 10km squares ... SO PLEASE, PLEASE KEEP UP THE GOOD WORK TILL THE END!!!
