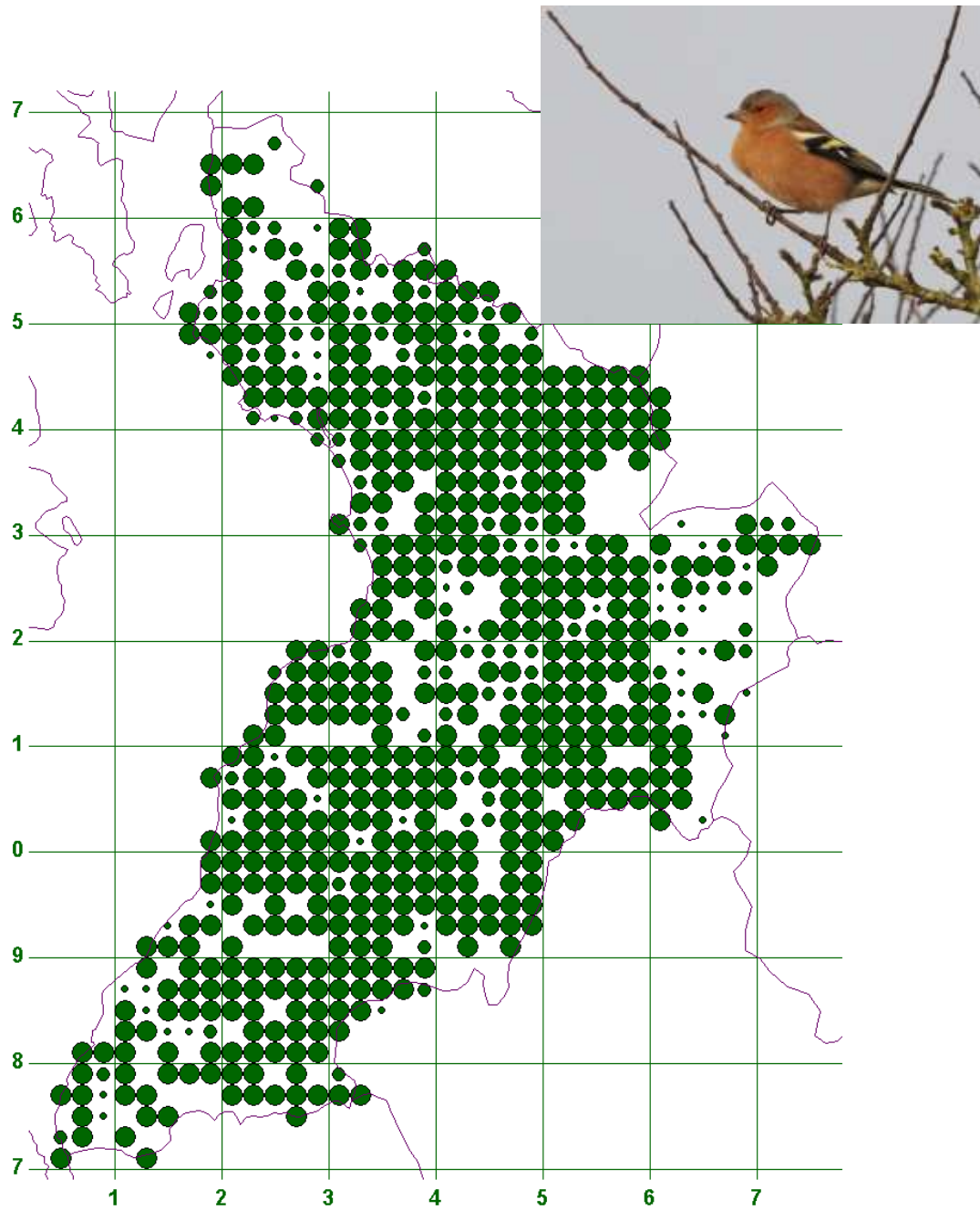


Chaffinch (*Fringilla coelebs*)



Status: Common breeder

Current trend: Widespread and common within the county, the Chaffinch has been another species to benefit from an increase in suitable breeding habitat, largely through the spread of forestry. A more generalist feeder than many other finches, it has been able to successfully exploit most rural and urban habitats.

Follow up: Continued monitoring of population through local censuses.
