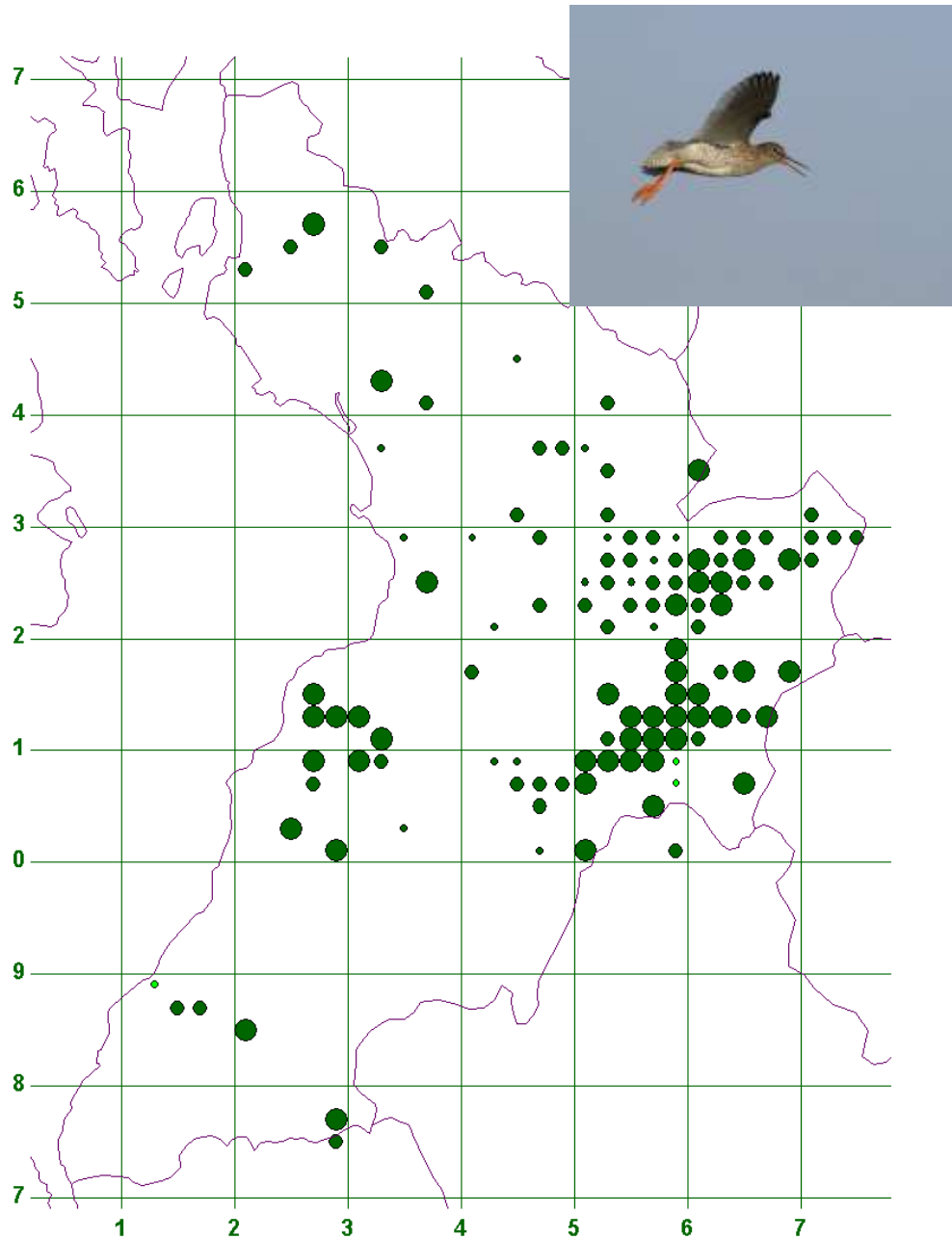


Redshank (*Tringa totanus*)



Status: Uncommon breeder

Current trend: Redshank may, by now, be a scarce breeder within Ayrshire, with many of its lowland wetland sites having disappeared, and upland breeding sites under pressure from a range of problems including forestry and the associated predation from Fox and Carrion Crow. The map above shows a distribution which is now much reduced, the healthiest element of this population now existing in parts of East Ayrshire.

Follow up: An effort should be made to monitor the breeding population in East Ayrshire and provide adequate protection for it.
