

Sedge Warbler (Acrocephalus schoenobaenus)

Status: Common breeder

Current trend: Nesting in a wide variety of sites, Sedge Warbler is a very successful migrant breeder. The highest numbers of Sedge Warblers can be found at places like Ardeer Fen and Bogton Moss, where there are large areas of reedbed and rough grass. However, it will also nest in hedgerows on lowland farmland, and virtually any area of undisturbed scrub,

Follow up: Continued reporting of breeding birds will be useful in detecting any long-term population change.
