
Tree Pipit (Anthus trivialis)



Status: Uncommon breeder

Current trend: The map above shows a much wider range than currently exists. There has been a contraction from many lowland areas e.g. Glen App to upland forestry plantations, particularly into and around re-stocks, where it maintains a stronghold. While habitat change may largely be the cause of this move, it doesn't appear to offer the full answer. By contrast, much of North Ayrshire has no breeding Tree Pipits.

Follow up: Continued recording of breeding birds in their current strongholds to detect any future change.
