

Treecreeper (Certhia familiaris)

Status: Common breeder

Current trend: Unobstrusive but widespread, the Treecreeper often goes unnoticed in many of our woodlands. Nonetheless, it is present in both lowland and upland woodlands, and is only affected by prolonged, severe winters, although it can cope well with low temperatures over a short period of time. The map probably underestimates its true presence.

Follow up: Continuing reporting of presence in Ayrshire woodlands will be useful.
