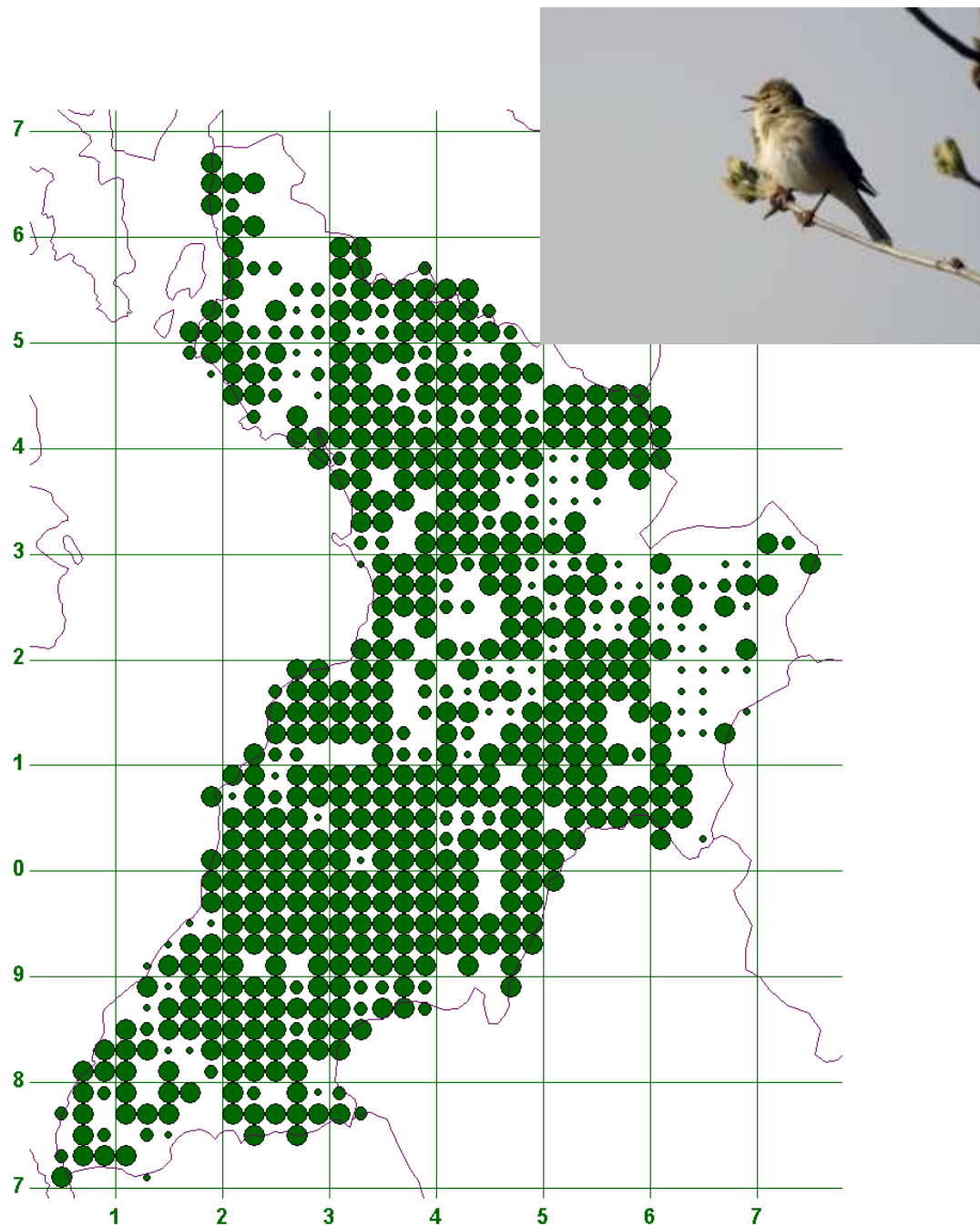


Willow Warbler (*Phylloscopus trochilus*)



Status: Common breeder

Current trend: Willow Warbler is extremely successful as a migrant breeder. Few tetrads remained unoccupied by breeding birds in 1997, and there seems little doubt that this situation continues. Its versatility allows it to use a wide range of woodland habitats, from upland conifer plantations to lowland deciduous woods and even suburban gardens.

Follow up: More data on breeding success rates would be useful.
