## **Editorial**

Welcome to the 2021 Ayrshire Bird Report. Another report finished, and another year "caught up." The aim is to get the Ayrshire Bird Report back on track by the end of next year, but none of this would be possible without help from a great number of people, and particular thanks must go to our local recorder, Fraser Simpson, for his assistance with numerous queries regarding records. Please remember to keep sending your records to him at <a href="mailto:recorder@ayrshire-birding.org.uk">recorder@ayrshire-birding.org.uk</a> or on any of the alternative recording systems e.g. BirdTrack.

For anyone who has submitted records and is wondering why they do not appear in the report, they still exist on the "master" spreadsheet held by the local recorder. This forms the base for the bird report, and these records are important in offering a more complete picture of events in Ayrshire for any given year, while the bird report concentrates on features like trends and highlights. Either way, one important aspect of SOC recording remains – verification. All records which appear within the report have been checked, and while occasional errors will occur from time to time, every effort is made to provide a totally accurate publication.

With the issue of verification in mind, it's perhaps worth saying something about record submission. Occasionally, you might be lucky enough to find a bird which is scarce in the county, or even a national rarity. Recorders will usually ask the observer to submit anything from a few notes on the sighting, to writing up a description on an online form. Photographs of the bird taken at the time can also be a particularly useful addition.

It's particularly important to help with this, since records of rare birds can't be accepted by the recorder unless they've been verified. Normally, this task is undertaken by a body like the Scottish Birds Records Committee (SBRC) or the British Birds Rarities Committee (BBRC). Your attention is drawn to a list of scarce or rare species appearing at the end of the report.

One or two other tips when submitting records:

- Location. Try to give the location of the nearest town or village to where you saw the bird. Many farms in Ayrshire share the same name, so it's helpful if a nearby settlement is given. Additionally, if you have a map handy at the time, a six-figure grid reference is good.
- Counts. It is useful to have some idea of how many birds are present even for low numbers of birds. A rough estimate would be adequate for large groups e.g. a flock of geese.

2021 was, in many ways, quite a remarkable year, with as many as 3 "new" birds added to the county list. Both Cetti's Warbler and Pallas's Warbler have already been accepted by the relevant assessment panels, while the Ross's Goose is currently with the BBRC. In all these cases, photographs were available, helping to make the verification job that bit easier.

The report uses the systematic order currently adopted by both the British Ornithologists' Union and the SOC. Some important changes to scientific names have appeared and we've adopted these too, along with the commonly used vernacular names. This is a constantly changing scene and one which we hope we've managed to keep up with. Also in the process of change are the species status symbols. This is still a work in progress, and we're always looking for volunteers to help with bird report work.

Finally, our thanks are due to Kevin Waite for his continued help with the online provision of this report on the Ayrshire Birding website, Tom Byars for his annual Lesser Whitethroat report, and Dougie Edmond and Hayden Fripp for their photographic contributions.

## The Lesser Whitethroat in Ayrshire – 2021 by Tom Byars

Due to family health issues, field work was limited mainly to my I.C.I. study site in Ardeer. Four territories were found in Ayrshire, three in I.C.I. Ardeer, North Ayrshire, and the other at Bower Hill, South Ayrshire. The scarcity of Lesser Whitethroat records elsewhere in Ayrshire may reflect a low number of returning spring birds.

#### Arrival

The first bird to arrive was located on the west side of the study site, at Ardeer boundary Fence on 26<sup>th</sup> April.

#### **Territories**

A territorial male at Ardeer Boundary Fence on 28<sup>th</sup> April was probably the same bird as that on 26<sup>th</sup> April. Later, on 1<sup>st</sup> May, a pair was located roving between Ardeer boundary fence and Ardeer Fen. By 14<sup>th</sup> May, 3 territories had been located at:

- Ardeer Fen (West)
- Ardeer boundary fence
- Ardeer Fen (East)

In South Ayrshire, another male was found to be holding territory at a second study site, on Bower Hill on 7<sup>th</sup> May.

#### **Breeding Summary**

Two pairs located at Ardeer boundary Fence, had contiguous territories, both pairs visibly agitated by their proximity to each other on 22<sup>nd</sup> May. On 28<sup>th</sup> May two pairs in the same area were displaying vigorously to each other, with erect postures, raised crown feathers and shivering wings. They were also heard giving Blue Tit-like "chirrit" calls to each other. One of the breeding males here was caught on 29<sup>th</sup> May and ringed on the left leg with a BTO ring.

On 5<sup>th</sup> June, a pair was watched making long food forays into Ardeer Fen (East), 200m away from the hidden nest location at Ardeer boundary fence – maybe to avoid challenges from other breeding pairs? This pair (including the ringed male) was seen taking caterpillars and *tipulidae* from hawthorn canopy and flying 200m back to the nest site. The other (unringed) pair collected food from hawthorn canopy in Ardeer boundary fence on 9<sup>th</sup> June avoiding any interaction with its neighbours.

By 12<sup>th</sup> June, the pair (including the ringed male) was feeding three recently fledged young, hidden in dense gorse & bramble scrub, giving "neigh" begging food calls. At this stage they would be just a day out of nest. On 18<sup>th</sup> June, it was a hive of activity at Ardeer boundary fence as seven individuals were present within a ten square metre area. The breeding pair (including the ringed male) was feeding three fledged young, approximately seven days out of nest, with the other breeding pair in close proximity, but not interacting with the feeding party.

I found the nest of one of the breeding pairs at **Ardeer boundary fence** on  $21^{st}$  June. It was in a dense patch of rosebay willowherb, gorse & bramble. The nest was anchored to three bramble stems running horizontally underneath the nest base, using the tiny spines running longitudinally on the bramble stems (1-3mm in length) to hook and fasten the nest base, Velcro-like, very securely. This is the first time I've seen this form of adherence of the nest to bramble spines. Normally the nest is woven around three vertical branches with the nest rim having three points of contact. The nest's height was only 66.5cm from the ground, also making it one of the lowest nest placements recorded in the long-term study (this observation was submitted as a short note to *Scottish Birds* and has been accepted).

The unringed male at Ardeer boundary fence was still singing on territory on 21<sup>st</sup> June, indicating that this pair may have failed to breed successfully. By 27<sup>th</sup> June, the successful family party of two adults and three juveniles were still at Ardeer boundary fence, and the unringed male was still singing. Two birds were also mist netted, an adult female and a juvenile – both BTO ringed on the right leg.

#### Ringing

In total, three birds were caught in the I.C.I. study site at Ardeer boundary fence (probably from the same family party).



Elsewhere 1 flew east at Skelmorlie on 31 Mar, a pair had returned to another breeding site on 3 Apr, and 1 was at Knockendon Res on 10 Apr. Other singles appeared at Knockshinnoch lagoons on 11 Apr, Munnoch Res on 14 Apr, Martnaham Loch on 24 May, and Ardmillan on 6 Jun.

In the autumn, singles were observed at Hunterston from 14 Aug-4 Sep, Bogside on 21 Sep and Culzean on 28 Sep.

## Golden Eagle Aquila chrysaetos U (B)

An imm, possibly from the current re-introduction scheme, was watched over Eldrick Hill on 18 Mar (RHH), while another imm (satellite-tagged) flew N over Carlock Hill on 12 Apr (RHH).

# Eurasian Sparrowhawk Accipiter nisus CB

Breeding: reported widely within the county with examples from suitable areas at Dean Castle CP (min B/2), Hunterston, Ardeer, Saltcoats, Blackbarn Farm, Birkhill Farm, Cumnock, Culzean, Kilcase Wood, and Loch Macaterick.

## Northern Goshawk Accipiter gentilis U (B)

3 breeding sites were occupied by adult pairs, and there was a single adult at another. At least one egg was laid at 1 site, but the outcome was unknown. Another pair of adults was present at a site in Glen App on 12 Apr, but no further details were obtained.

A single calling bird was heard at Macherquhat on 10 Apr.

# Western Marsh Harrier Circus aeruginosus R P (B)

Up to 5 individuals were reported, involving a  $\triangleleft$  at Fail on 19 Jun (FMcC), a juv at Bogside/Garnock Floods from 25-29 Aug (DG *et al.*), a  $\triangleleft$  at Bogside from 2-8 Sep (GMcA *et al.*), a  $\triangleleft$  at Auchincross on 7 Sep (MH), and another juv at Bogside from 10-12 Sep (TB).

# Hen Harrier Circus cyaneus Ubp

No reports were received from breeding areas.

Migrants and wintering birds were reported from Hunterston, Glengarnock, Barrmill, Garnock Floods, Ashgrove Loch, Bogside, Fail, Auchincross, Belston Loch, Martnaham Loch, Maidens (in off sea), and Garnaburn Bridge.

#### Red Kite Milvus milvus FB A

Observations of 1-3 birds continued throughout the year in the Patna-Loch Doon area. Elsewhere, singles were noted at Corsencon 27 Mar, Straiton 31 Mar, Skares 6 Apr, Hollybush 15 Apr, Darnhay 19 Jun, New Cumnock 20 Jun, Kelburn 24 Jul. and Culzean 28 Sep. An ad and 2 juvs were seen at roadkill near New Cumnock on 6 Oct. Two more singles were seen at Crosshands on 14 Oct, and Stevenston Point on 22 Oct.

#### Common Buzzard Buteo buteo CB

A widespread and common breeding raptor.

Dupin (B/2 noted), Campbelton Hill (B/1 noted), Kelburn CP, Brisbane Glen, Outerwards, Hillhouse, Blackburn Farm, Ardeer, Pogiven Bridge, Dean Castle CP, Loudoun Hill, Fail, Sorn, Ballochmyle, Auchincross, Craigdullyeart, Auchincruive, Adamton House, Annbank, Shewalton Wood, Troon South Woods, Martnaham Loch, Hollybush, Craigengillan, Kilcase Wood, Craigens Kirkoswald, Brunston Castle, Culzean, South Balloch, Stinchar Falls, and Finnarts Bay.

Migration/counts: 12 Auchincross/Dalgig 12 Sep, 10 Fail 31 Oct.

One was watched excavating a Mole hill at Lugar on 16 Feb – apparently with some success.

No reports were received from breeding areas.

Counts/migrants: 1 Blackcraig Hill 13 May was the only spring record.

In the autumn-winter period: present at Bogside from 10 Oct-end Dec, with a peak count of 5 on 12 Oct, 1 Airds Moss 22 Oct, 1 Barassie 17 Nov.

#### Tawny Owl Strix aluco CB

Breeding pairs or territorial birds were noted at Craigens Kirkoswald (2), Ardeer Fen, Shewalton Wood, Annbank, Martnaham, Kilcase Wood, Drumgirnan.

In winter, singles were reported from Auchincruive, Fencefoot and Tallaminnoch.
